FIREWORK SAFETY CODE

- **Buy fireworks marked CE**
- **Keep fireworks in a closed metal box and use them one at a time**
- **Read and follow the instructions on each firework**
- **Light the fireworks at arm's length with a taper and stand well back**
- **Keep naked flames, including cigarettes, away from fireworks**
- **Never return to a firework once it has been lit**
- **Never put fireworks in pockets or throw them**
- **Light sparklers one at a time and wear gloves**
- **Keep a bucket of water nearby at all times**
- **Alcohol and fireworks do not mix and may lead to injury**
- **Keep pets indoors**
